The City of Alexander City is in the process of closing their FY 2014 Community Development Block Grant (Project #: LR-CE-PF-14-013), which as part of this project the city demolished 22 vacant dilapidated homes, 1 vacant City owned Warehouse facility (Office Section of old Alabama Food Group (located on Franklin Street), 1 vacant, abandoned sewer facility (located at the end of Nolen Drive) and the dilapidated, abandoned 250,000 gallon water tank (located on Summer Street).
