



Transformer Bid Recommendations

Dear Ms. Stewart:

Find enclosed separate Certified Bid Tabulation for the Substation Transformers as bid on April 15, 2024.

We recommend that the two (2) transformers, manufactured by Pennsylvania Transformer Technology, Inc. (PTT), be purchased from PTT, the low bidder, with a low Bid of \$1,533,898 (\$766,949 each). We recommend that you review the PTT Standard Terms and Conditions of Sale and, if in agreement with all stipulations, issue a Purchase Order as soon as possible. You should contact Mr. Jim Farrar with Whitehead & FOR PUBLIC RELEASE instructions on issuing the Purchase Order.

There are two (2) Options for Payment. Option 1 (recommended) requires 50% of contract price due upon the order, 25% due upon receipt of core steel and copper, 20% due upon completion of factory acceptance testing, with remaining 5% balance due upon shipment. This Option allows the Contract Price to remain fixed. Option 2 offers escalated pricing with payment terms, smaller percentages due up front, but with price escalation clauses. We have attached a separate copy of this page from the bid documents to help you better understand these PTT Options.

All original bid documents will be returned next week, for your records.
