**CALL TO ORDER THE PRE-COUNCIL MEETING:** Council President Spraggins called the Pre-Council Meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 18, 2018, in the City Hall Conference Room. Councilwoman Colvin, Councilman Brown, Council President Tommy Spraggins, and Councilman Funderburk were present.

During the Pre-Council Meeting Council President Spraggins asked the following persons to inform the Council of the following items.

Capitan Brewer presented the Council with the information and details on the grant through Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program which will help aid in the purchase of new Self-Contained Breathing Apparatuses for the Fire Department. Brewer stated that the City purchased 40 new apparatuses in 2005 and they are now old enough and in need of replacement. He stated that the max life on this particular equipment is 15 years. Ours are currently 13 years old. The purchase will be for one face mask for every two bottles. Councilman Funderburk asked if there was a way we could wait on this decision. Council President Spraggins asked how long we had before we need to give a definite answer?

Al Jones informed the Council that the City's match for the Sportplex Boulevard Bridge Replacement (Project No. ACBRZ61056-ATRIP (017); ATRIP No. 62-05-08; BIN No. 016025) is \$109,011.18, which is approximately \$8,000.00 more than anticipated.
