To Authorize the Mayor to Apply for Funds through the EMA Hazard Mitigation Grant

Program for a Generator in an Amount not to Exceed \$62,500.00

WHEREAS, the City of Alexander City (City) has an opportunity to apply for a

grant through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), DR-4710 (severe storms

and tornadoes); and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, the funds will be used to add and install a generator at

the Washington Street water tank; and

**WHEREAS**, the generator can assist with consistently supplying water to more

than 9,330 customers; and

WHEREAS, the cost is \$250,000.00, requiring twenty-five percent (25%)

matching funds of \$62,500.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Alexander

City authorize the mayor of Alexander City to sign any and all documents to apply for

HMGP grant funds for a generator to be installed at the Washington Street water tank

for the City of Alexander City, Alabama.

## RESOLUTION

To Provide for the Elimination of a Grade Crossing at 17<sup>th</sup> Street W, DOT #728239C, RR Milepost P-365.03

**WHEREAS**, it is within the authority of City of Alexander City to voluntarily eliminate grade crossings within the city road system; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined reasonably necessary in the interest of public safety to eliminate highway grade crossing, 17th St. W - DOT# 728239C, RR Milepost P-365.03; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the enhancement of public safety resulting from such elimination of the grade crossing will outweigh any inconvenience to the reasonable passage of public traffic, specifically including without limitation emergency vehicle traffic, caused by rerouting such traffic; and

WHEREAS, the closing of the crossing 17th St. W - DOT# 728239C, RR Milepost P-365.03

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Alexander City, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same, as follows:

**Section 1**. The City hereby directs the elimination of the highway grade Crossing, 17th St. W - DOT#728239C, RR Milepost P-365.03.

**Section 2**. A copy of this resolution shall be served on Norfolk Southern Corporation.

**Section 3**. Norfolk Southern Corporation shall at its expense physically remove the crossing from the tracks and beyond the ends of the crossties on each side and erect approved barricades, to be maintained by the City thereafter, and the City may remove the remaining approaches to the crossing at its discretion.

**Section 4**. Upon receipt of a signed resolution, Norfolk Southern Corporation will issue an incentive payment of \$15,000 made payable to the City of Alexander City.

**Section 5**. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

## RESOLUTION
