Fiction dominates our checkouts, so let's look at a few of *Times*' best sellers in our collection for the week of April 28, 2024.

The Familiar, by best-selling author Leigh Bardugo, is described as a spellbinding novel set in the Spanish Golden Age. This book comes in at #2 on the list. *Toxic Prey*, by consistent favorite John Sandford, is #4 on the list. It features a dangerous scientist whose latest project could endanger the entire world. Lucas Davenport teams up with his daughter to track him down. At #6 we have Amor Towles' *Table for Two*, a sharp-edged satire deceptively wrapped like a box of Neuhaus chocolates. Finally, we have Megan Miranda's *Daughter of Mine*, a psychological thriller where the secrets of Mirror Lake are coming to the surface and changing everything.
