

RESOLUTION

To Declare Personal Property as Surplus and No Longer Needed for Public Use

WHEREAS, the City of Alexander City, Alabama, is the owner of certain property which is no longer needed for public or municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-43-56, Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended, authorizes the municipal governing body to dispose of unneeded personal property; and


WHEREAS, there are a large number of old parking meters that have been removed from the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the city will set a price of \$50.00 - \$100.00 dependent upon the condition of the individual meter, to be sold as is.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Alexander City, Alabama, hereby declares said property as surplus and no longer needed for public use; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alexander City, Alabama, hereby authorizes the Mayor, City Clerk, and Purchasing Agent to make the sale of these meters open to the general public. Said proceeds will be deposited to be used for upgrading the restroom facilities at the Thomas C. Russell Field pavilion. If any remaining property is not sold; the mayor has the authority to scrap or dispose of said property for and on behalf of the city.
