**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Alexander City, Alabama, hereby authorizes to filing of said survey which includes uploading an interest survey form and consent agreement form, and further directs and authorizes the mayor to sign said agreements and to provide such additional information as the SLCGP may require.

## State of Alabama Fiscal Year 2022 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program Local Consent Agreement

I, Curtis "Woody" Baird (Printed Name), the duly appointed authorized agency on behalf of the City of Alexander City, Alabama ("Local Governmental Entity"), located at 281 James D. Nabors Dr, Alexander City, AL (address) hereby expressly consent to the State of Alabama's State Administrative Agency (SAA), namely the State of Alabama Office of Information Technology (OIT), undertaking the following acts in accordance with the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022, Funding Opportunity DHS-22-137-000-01, as authorized by Section 2220A of the Homeland Security Act of 2022, as amended (Pub. L. No. 107-296) (6 U.S.C. §665g):

1. Retain \$769,719.20 in SLCGP funds for FY2022 at the State Level, as Management and Administration Costs, as well as SLCGP Operations Costs. Funds are in alignment and compliance with Federal allowances.
2. Utilize \$3,078,876.80 in SLCGP funds for FY2022 as follows:
  - a. 80% for security assessments and gap analysis, deployment of cybersecurity services, deployment of .gov email addresses, deployment of Incident Response (IR) plans, and assistance with cybersecurity monitoring and response for local government entities.
  - b. 20% for cybersecurity training for local government entities, to include training sessions, cybersecurity exercises, and training software programs.

This consent is given to be in the best interest of the Local Government Entity and is provided without duress or fear of reprisal. This consent is only effective for FY2022 SLCGP federal funds.
