

ALEXANDER CITY PARKS & RECREATION SWIMMING POOL RENTAL AGREEMENT

- 1. The responsible party must sign the release and hold harmless agreement.
- 2. Rental fees and lifeguard fees are due at the time of reservation.
 - Rental fees are \$50 for first two hours and \$20 for each additional hour.
 - Lifeguards fees are \$15 per hour, per Lifeguard.
 - o Only lifeguards employed through Alexander City Parks & Recreation may be used.
 - o 2 lifeguards required per 25 patrons attending the party (swimmers & non-swimmers).
 - o A minimum of 2 lifeguards on duty is required at all times.
 - Renter will be required to pay for additional lifeguards if attendance exceeds the limits for the number of lifeguards reserved.
- 3. Patrons may set up no sooner than 10 minutes before their scheduled time.
- 4. Patrons must clean up prior to their party's ending time and are responsible for any damage to equipment, property, etc.
- 5. Lifeguards will blow their whistles ten minutes before your party is scheduled to end to allow time for you to finish cleaning and for your guests to collect their belongings.
- 6. Alexander City Parks & Recreation must be given a notice of cancellation prior to the reservation date for you to receive a refund. This may be done by contacting the Pool Manager at (256) 596-1846 or by email at megan.blake@alexandercityal.gov.
 - 72 hour notice = 100% refund
 - 48 hour notice = 50% refund
 - 24 hour notice = 25% refund
 - Cancellations or date changes made on the day of the event = No refund
- 7. If Alexander City Parks & Recreation cancels reservations prior to the rental time due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances patrons will receive a full refund or may reschedule on another available date.
 - If the party is cancelled due to inclement weather after the party has started, the renter will receive a prorated refund of the rental fee but will be responsible for all lifeguard fees.
- 8. Renters also have an option to cancel the party due to inclement weather. * Inclement weather is defined as 50% chance of rain or weather warnings issued by the National Weather Service
 - Parties may be cancelled no sooner than 24 hours before scheduled reservations due to inclement weather only.
 - Parties must be cancelled at least two hour before scheduled time for renter to receive a refund for the lifeguards and 50% of the facility rental fee.
 - Renters must contact the Pool Manager at (256) 596-1846 or by email at megan.blake@alexandercityal.gov.
 - Please include the party name, phone number, date, time, etc. on any messages or emails sent.
 - Renters will be responsible for all fees if these calls/emails are not made in time.
- 9. No cooking is permitted. No glass containers are permitted. Refrigerator space is not available.



- 10. Music must be appropriate and may not be played at loud volumes.
- 11. Decorations must be plastic. Do not decorate with crape paper or anything that would leave a stain if it gets wet.
- 12. The Alexander City Pool is a non-smoking facility. Absolutely NO drugs or alcohol are not allowed on the property.
- 13. All posted rules must be followed and lifeguard commands must be obeyed.
- 14. Parents or responsible adult guardian must supervise his or her own child.
- 15. All children who are not potty-trained must wear a swim diaper. Regular diapers may burst or leak. Feces in pool water spread a host of infectious diseases. One child could contaminate thousands of gallons of water. Anyone who has diarrhea within the past two weeks should stay out of the water. If a child defecates in the water, please notify a lifeguard or pool manager. Please do not use poolside or tables for changing diapers.

SWIMMING POOL RULES

- 1. Lifeguard instructions must be obeyed at all times.
- 2. No running or rough play
- 3. No diving in shallow end of pool (less than 6 feet)
- 4. No swimming in designated diving areas
- 5. No flotation devices allowed. Toys and balls will be allowed only upon the approval of the Pool Manager and must remain in the shallow end.
- 6. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at one time.
- 7. Swimmers must dive straight out and not off the side of the diving boards and only when the area is clear of other swimmers.
- 8. Only one bounce on the boards.
- 9. Swim to the closest ladder and use ladder to exit when going to diving boards.
- 10. No pets, loud music, smoking, alcohol, or glass containers allowed.
- 11. No profanity or improper behavior allowed.
- 12. No cooking or glass containers permitted.
- 13. Proper swim attire required, no diapers allowed.
- 14. An adult must accompany all children under age 13.
