THE CITY OF ALEXANDER CITY CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATIONS

Contractors performing work on the City's water and sewer infrastructure must be approved by the City. Contractors seeking to be approved may do so by filing a written request with the City through its consulting engineer at the following address:

To be considered for approval, the contractor must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Have a valid Alabama General Contractors License for utility construction.
- 2. Have or have the ability to obtain a General Liability insurance policy of at least \$1,000,000 naming the City, its agents, engineers, and representatives as additional insured. Waiver of subrogation as to the additional insured shall also apply. A copy of the Contractor's proof of insurance must be on file with the City before work begins.
- 3. Have no outstanding claims of any kind for other projects installed on the City's system.
- 4. Provide 3 references for utility installation on other projects.
- 5. Shall provide a current copy of any bonds required from the municipality and/or County having jurisdiction over the right of way.
- 6. Shall not have a history of substandard work on other projects installed on the City's system.

The City will consider all requests for approval on a case by case basis. The City may require additional information from applicants or establish additional requirements as is deemed necessary to maintain the quality of the facilities being installed and the integrity of the City's system.
